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Getting There

Travel is via Johannesburg, followed by a domestic flight to Port Elizabeth in the Eastern Cape. Upon arrival, you will be met by your outfitter and transferred directly to the hunting area (approximately 1½ hours). Return airport transfers are included.

The Hunt

The hunt is conducted as a classic rifle hunt (1:1 or 2:1) with an experienced Professional Hunter (PH), focusing on the selection of quality trophy animals in an area known for its high game density and wide variety of species.

You hunt under genuine fair chase conditions on one large, continuous hunting area – without small fenced enclosures – ensuring an authentic and exciting hunting experience. The terrain ranges from open plains and rolling hills to dense bushveld, creating ideal conditions for classic African plains game hunting.

The area is particularly renowned for its strong populations of impala and kudu, and hunters generally experience abundant game sightings and numerous hunting opportunities throughout their stay.

The Hunting Area

Frontier Safaris manages an impressive continuous hunting concession of 32,000 hectares in the Eastern Cape, including the scenic Burchell Game Reserve.

The area offers spectacular scenery, high game densities and an impressive variety of plains game species. It is also considered some of the finest kudu habitat in the region.

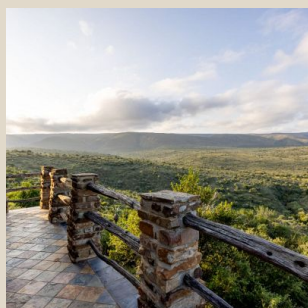
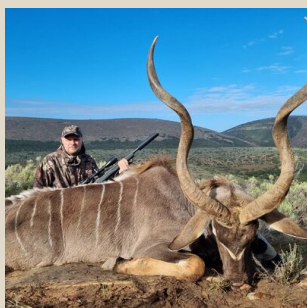
Accommodation

Guests stay at Frontier Safaris' comfortable Masada Lodge, centrally located within the hunting area and offering magnificent views of the surrounding landscape.

Accommodation includes full board, as well as beer and

wine. After a day in the bush, guests often gather around the campfire in the traditional African boma, sharing the day's experiences over a fine dinner beneath the stars.

The package includes 6 days of hunting, accommodation and full board.



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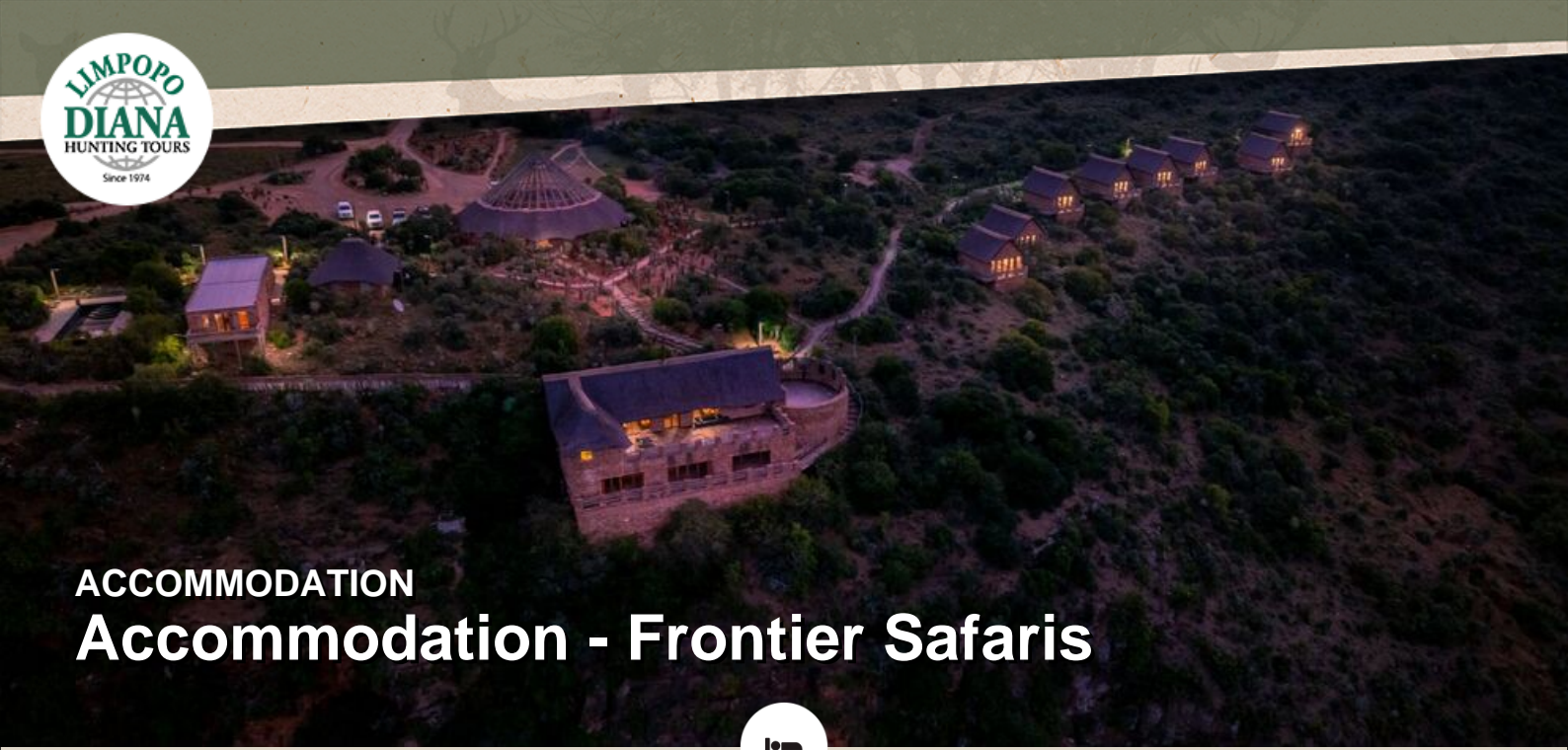
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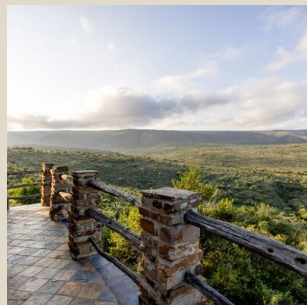
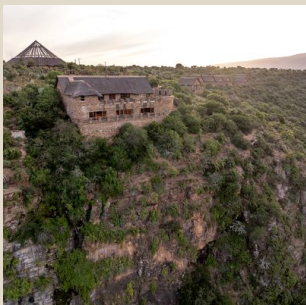
ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation - Frontier Safaris



The camp is beautifully situated with a view over the bush, and the accommodation takes place in spacious bungalows built from stones from the bush. Each bungalow has its own bathroom, and a great view. There is a total of 16 bungalows, so this place is suitable for bigger group.

There is also a swimming pool, if you should need to be cooled down. The meals you have either in the common lodge or in the boma, where the food is being served in nice surroundings with a fire in the evening, and where there is also a bar area.



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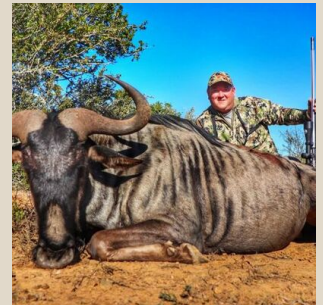

Frontier Safaris arrange hunting in their own area Burchell Game Reserve in the Eastern Cape Province in South Africa. This area is situated about 110 km from the airport in Port Elizabeth (you fly domestic from Johannesburg to Port Elizabeth). Frontier Safaris naturally pick-up and take back their guests from/to Port Elizabeth. Burchell Game Reserve is incredible 27.000 hectares. A really beautiful area, in many places hilly and mountainous, but they also have flat and more open areas in the valleys and on top of the mountains. We have now been working with Frontier Safaris for 8 seasons, and the hunters we send there to hunt, return with very good feedback.



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HUNTING AREA Burchell Game Reserve



Frontier Safaris' hunting area is one big area of 32.000 hectares - with open plains, mountains and thick bush.

In the hunting area you can hunt a lot of different species, however none of the Big Five, but there is a very big variety of antelopes from the small Grey Duiker to the big Cape Eland.

Although it is sold at discount prices, there is nothing lacking with the hunting, accommodation, food or trophy quality - quite the opposite! The hunt takes place on a well cared for district covering 27,000 hectares in one continuous area - quite big enough for the game populations to live out a natural life in the bush.

Here you hunt in the traditional way - on foot, after the game has been spotted from a vehicle. In this district you can find good populations of all the local native antelope species such as kudu, blue and black wildebeest, eland, waterbuck, oryx, zebra etc. In total you can hunt approx. 30 species here!

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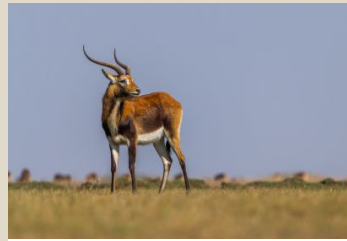

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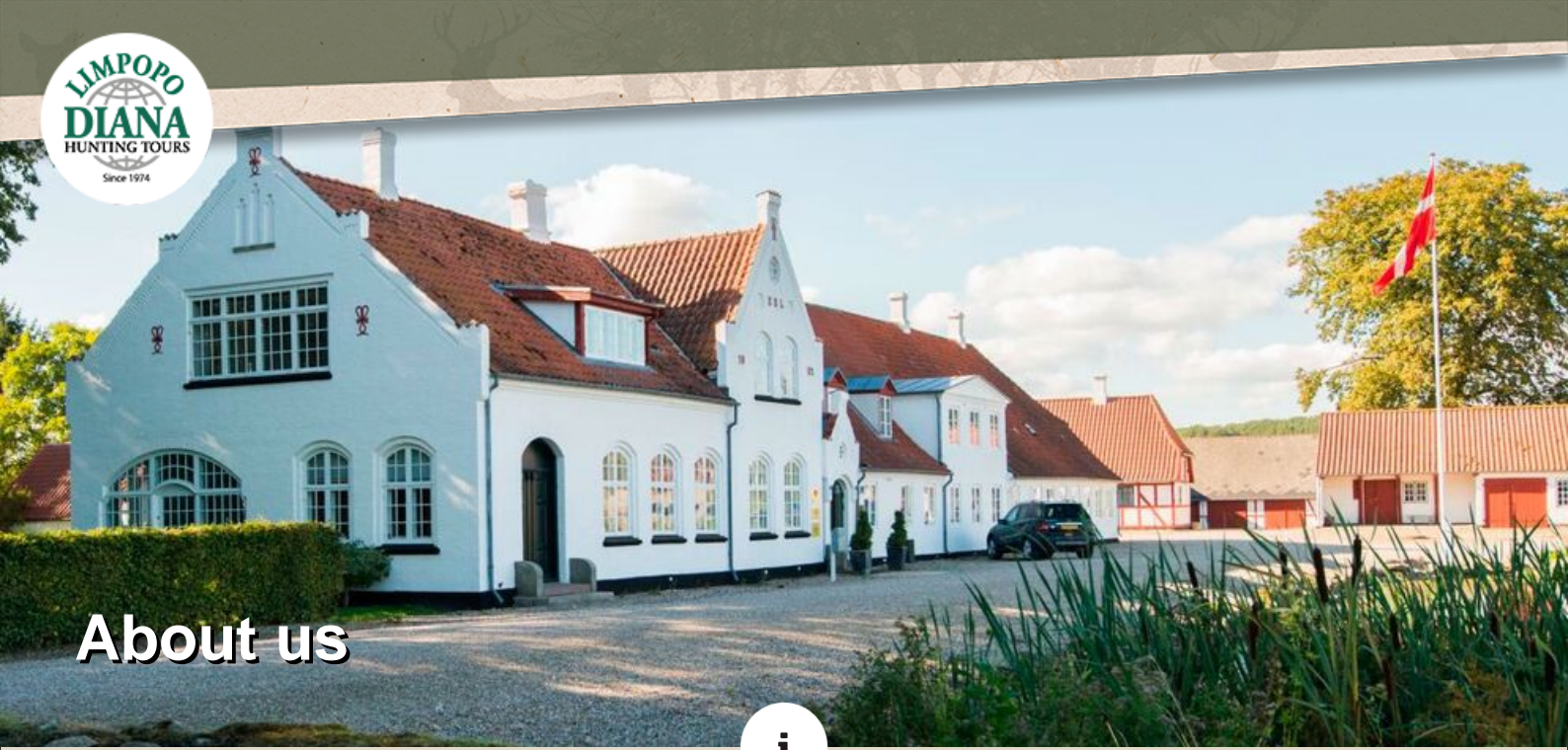
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About us
